

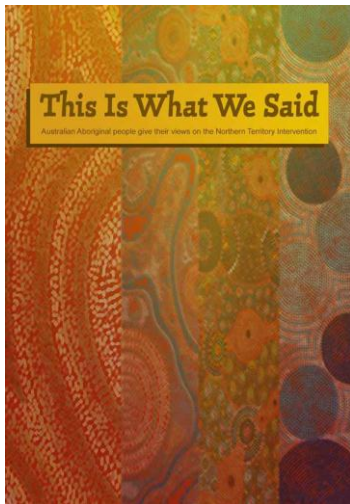
“This Is What We Said”

‘*This Is What We Said*’ was launched in February 2010. Using pictures and quotations taken from footage of actual consultations at Bagot, Ampilatwatja, Utopia and Yirrkala in 2009, plus quotes from other well known Australians and UN representatives, this book provides a graphic account of true feelings of many Aboriginal people in the Northern Territory about the Intervention. The legislation passed by Parliament in June paid scant attention to the views expressed by many Aboriginal people during the consultations process.
